## THE PEOPLE'S PARTY PLATFORM

### CUT TAXES & BALANCE BUDGET

As a responsible government, the PPC will prioritize spending cuts, a balanced budget, and prudent tax relief to put more money in your pockets.

- No income tax under \$15k
- 15% flat tax under \$100k
- 25% over \$100k
- Reduce corporate tax to 10% to stimulate the economy
- Reduce the budget of the CBC - SAVE \$1B
- Cut foreign development aid - SAVE \$5B
- Cut corporate welfare - SAVE \$5B - \$10B
- A concrete plan to balance the budget in 2 yrs

### IMMIGRATION PLATFORM

The Liberals and Conservatives both seem determined to bring 350,000 immigrants to Canada - per year. While the PPC is a pro-immigration Party, we do not believe 350,000 immigrants per year is sustainable.

The PPC will:

- Stop the flow of illegal migrants at the US-Canadian border
- Withdraw from the UN Compact on Migration
- Lower immigration to 150,000 per year
- Implement face-to-face interviews, values tests and thorough background checks
- Accept fewer refugees but prioritize persecuted people
- Limit immigration via "family reunification"
- Increase skilled immigrants to 50%

### PIPELINES - ALLOWING OUR OIL & GAS INDUSTRY TO GROW

Bring investment, jobs and prosperity back:

- Repeal Bill C-48 - The "no tankers" Bill
- Repeal Bill C-69 - The "no pipelines" Bill
- Streamline the pipeline approval process
- Find a private buyer for Trans Mountain
- Use Section 92 (10) of the Constitution to "impose" pipelines on dissenting Provinces by declaring pipelines to be of general advantage to Canada

### GLOBAL WARMING & THE ENVIRONMENT

Given numerous failed prediction of calamity (since the 1970's) and significant scientific uncertainties about climate change, the PPC sees no compelling reason to jeopardize the prosperity of Canada with the huge costs of the measures designed to fight global warming.

The PPC will:

- Withdraw from the UN Paris Accord
- Stop sending Billions to developing countries to help them reduce emissions
- Abolish subsidies for green technologies
- Let the private sector develop profitable and efficient alternatives
- Leave emission reductions to the Provinces
- Bring clean drinking water to First Nations communities
- Abolish the Carbon Tax

### HEALTH CARE

Canada now has the worst wait times of any country in the developed world! But who should we hold accountable?

Health Care is a Provincial jurisdiction and throwing more federal money at the problem is not the right approach.

The PPC will:

- Stabilize funding for Provincial health care by effectively giving them the GST revenue (currently \$40B) instead of Health Transfer payments
- Make Provinces fully responsible & accountable to their voters for Health Care provision. This will encourage them to innovate and improve service provision
